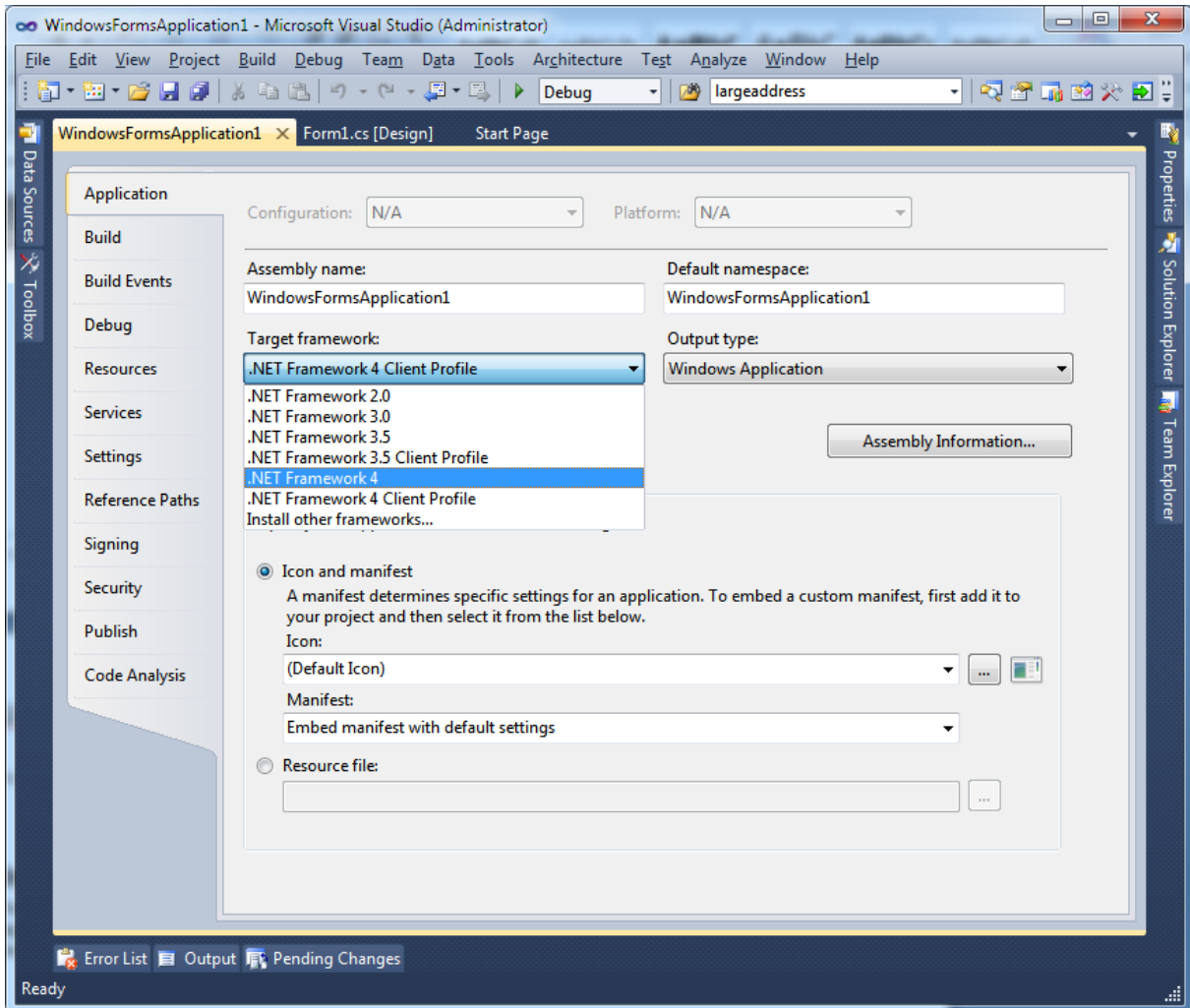

## Building in Visual Studio 2010

Visual Studio 2010 builds against the Client Profile frameworks by default. However, all versions of QIOS DevSuite depend on assemblies (System.Design for instance) not delivered in the Client Profile. Therefore you need to select a Full .NET Framework. You do this in the properties of a project.





## Manual integration into Visual Studio 2010

QIOS DevSuite 3.0 and lower do not integrate with Visual Studio 2010.  
**QIOS DevSuite 4.0 does integrate with Visual Studio 2010.**

It is still possible to use QIOS DevSuite 3.0 and lower with Visual studio 2010. Do the following to integrate QIOS DevSuite into Visual Studio 2010:

1. Install QIOS DevSuite on your development system.
2. Open Visual Studio and start a new Forms project
3. Open the ToolBox and make a new Tab "Qios.DevSuite"
4. Go to c:\program files\qios\qios.devsuite.components 3.0\ (or your installation folder)
5. Drag Qios.DevSuite.Components.dll into the ToolBox.
